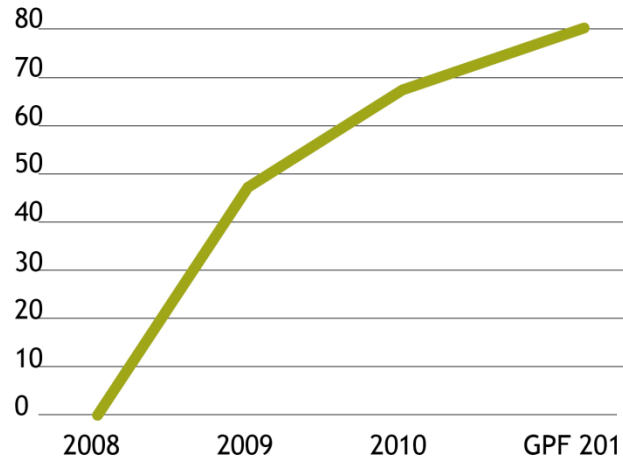

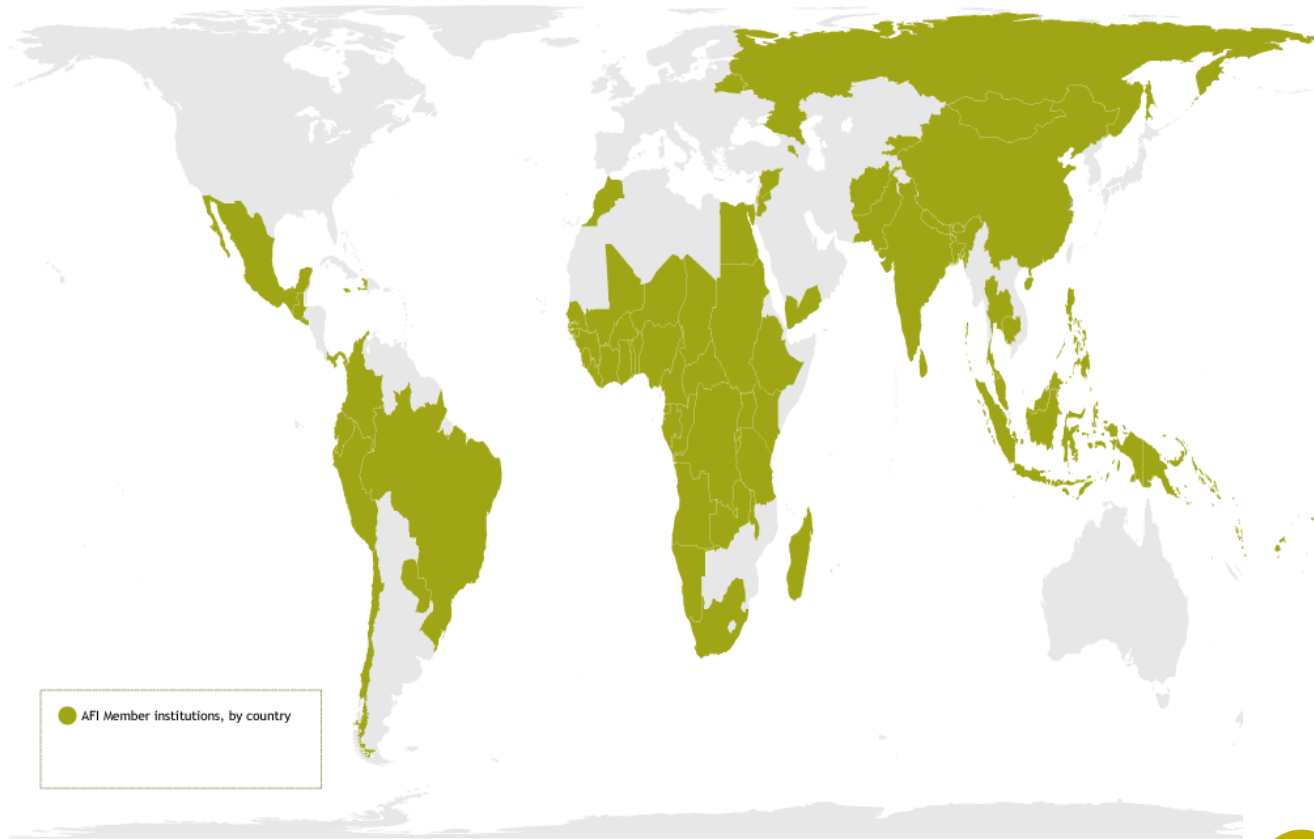

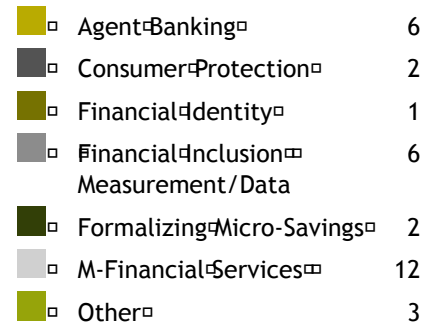

Grants by region, 2009-2011

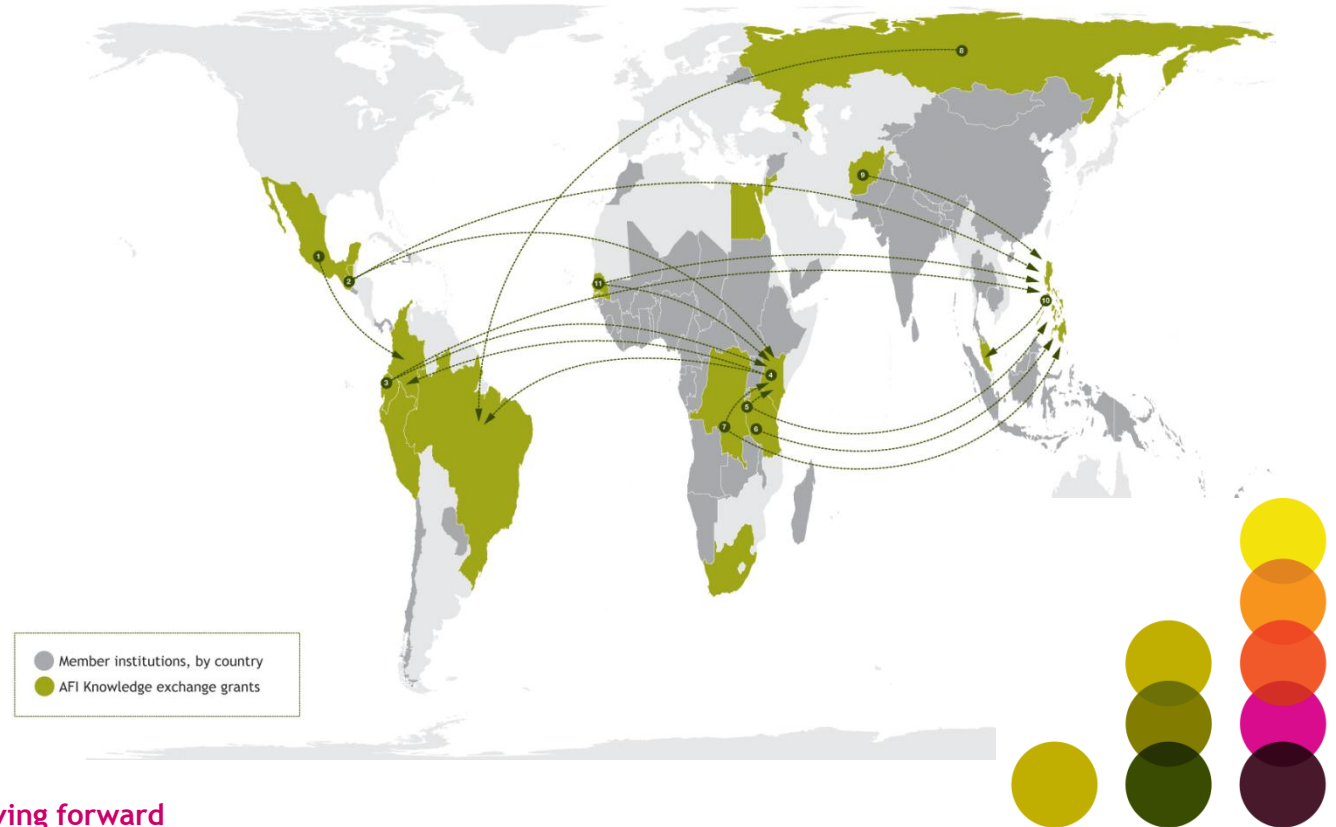


Grants by policy area, 2009-2011
