# The 2012 AFI Global Policy Forum: Making financial inclusion real

This year, with the theme *Making financial inclusion real*, the Forum aims to ensure the commitments made under the Maya Declaration in 2011 are being turned into reality through results-oriented progress tracking, and that ways to better optimize the positive impacts of financial inclusion, moving forward, are identified. Forum discussions will: 1) glean lessons learned from the progress achieved by the Maya Declaration; 2) focus on practical policy solutions that facilitate the achievement of the commitments; and 3) elaborate on the broader impacts of financial inclusion on the real economy—its role in poverty alleviation, boosting employment, redressing inequality, and promoting long term economic growth. Furthermore, marking an important milestone in AFI's history, this year's Forum will elevate the network as a unique peer-learning and progress review platform for financial inclusion that is fully driven by its members, and will highlight its sustainable long-term path with developing and emerging country ownership and leadership at the core.

The AFI members' commitment to make real impact through financial inclusion is strong. This year's overarching theme for the GPF could not be more timely: take the challenge and make your commitments count, let us make financial inclusion *real*.
