	<p>Members of the AFI network are highly committed to reaching the unbanked as reflected through the concrete financial inclusion targets that they have set and are implementing in the context of the Maya Declaration. By the 1<sup>st</sup> half of 2015, over 70% of all targets set under the Maya Declaration have been achieved, and about 40% of these account for completed targets with specific focus on digital financial services (DFS). This session aims to highlight AFI members’ contributions to the overall reduction of the global unbanked population with a particular focus on commitments and achievements in the area of DFS.
